You are required to respond to all requests promptly and at your own expense.

Warranty Cover

Synergy warrants all Synergy and Sky Equipment branded products against defects in materials under normal & proper use.

The warranty period commences from the date of purchase, stated on the proof of purchase document (Tax Invoice) for a period of

- One (1) year for: Mobile scaffold, trolleys, KwikAlly, FRP scaffold, ladders, Crane Bins, Skip Bins, Front/Rear loaded bins, Steel Acroprops, Form work H & V Frames, Form work base jacks & U Head Jacks.
- Ten (10) years for: Welding on all aluminium scaffold, aluminium props aluminium dolley trolleys & ladder components.
- Three (3) years for: Galvanised Steel, Galvanised Steel Acoustic & MDF access panels.

In addition, Synergy warrants that all scaffolding systems are structurally sound and have been tested locally (in Australia) to the Australian Standard 1576. Furthermore, all our scaffolding systems are registered and approved by Work Cover NSW with reciprocal rights in other states of Australia.

If you submit a valid claim under this warranty, Synergy will, at its option:

(i) repair the product;

(*ii*) replace the product with a product that is at least equivalent to the original product in function and quality; or

(iii) refund the purchase price. When a product or component is replaced or refunded, any replacement item becomes your property and the replaced item becomes Synergy's property.

If any additional warranty is issued by Synergy, the terms of that additional warranty prevail to the extent of any inconsistency. This product warranty is subject to the exclusions and conditions below



Warranty Exclusions

This warranty does not apply for products that:

- Are not purchased from Synergy or an authorised reseller
- Have been modified and/or altered without explicit and written consent from Synergy.
- Have not been fitted according to manufacturer's installation guide, and in the absence of a product specific installation guide, the industries proper method of installation.
- Are of natural timber or engineered wood construction and are fitted to areas of high moisture content (e.g bathrooms, steam rooms etc.)
- This warranty does not apply to damage caused by:
- The fitting or use of components not supplied by Synergy
- Repair, maintenance or service by a person not authorised by Synergy
- Corrosion to products caused by contact with acid and or other harsh corrosive chemicals
- Rain or moisture damage on any natural timber or engineered wood products.
- Normal wear and tear. Special Conditions

Synergy advises customers not to keep scaffold platforms in the rain and as a precaution to store in under cover, as plywood is an engineered timber that may delaminate under constant variation in the elements.
